We are sharing with you the schedule & criteria for assessment as defined in the circular in a simplified manner for a better clarity & understanding.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT SCHEME 2021-22

1. Academic session to be divided into 2 Terms with approx. 50% syllabus in each Term – Term I (50%) Term II (50%) At the end of each term there will be a term End exam with a weightage of 40 marks in each. Remaining 10 marks will be taken from Internal Assessments in each subject, in each Term (details of Internal Assessments given below)

2. Term I examination – At the end of Term I an exam will be conducted of 90 minutes duration with 40 marks weightage. (online /offline to be decided as per the situation)
3. At the end of Term II / year end an exam will be conducted of 2 hours duration of 40 marks in each subject (questions will be case based/situation based, open ended, short answers long answers etc.)

Note:- The format, shared with you through this circular is subject to the scenario at the end of each term. The final policy will be decided as per the board notification.
