



## ANNUAL REPORT (2021-22)

Past two years were the years of all odds and hardships for the education world, yet we stood, committed to the excellence.

With online classes our team tried to make the academics and activities connected with the students. It was seen by everyone of us that the competitions and activities in the physical scenario weren’t possible due to the pandemic but it couldn’t prove to be an abject constraint to our students as they showcased their energy and skills were served through online events and competitions.

Some of the glimpses of these are –

**Online Special Assemblies:** The session 2021-22 began from April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Here we were ready with the planning of special online assemblies so that students could get exposure and connect with their peers.

On April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 a special assembly on the Earth day was conducted by the students of grade VIII and it was really motivating for others to use the online platform. Hereafter special assemblies on Ambedkar Jayanti, Heritage Day, Earth Day, Mother’s Day, Eid-ul- Zuha, Doctor’s Day (Gratitude Assembly), Independence Day, Janmashtami, Ganesh Chaturthi, Dusshera , Back to School after summer vacation on the theme of ‘Young Warriors’ -were been conducted by the different classes.

After getting the school online again in January, special assembly on the theme of ‘Joy of Sharing’ was also conducted.

Witnessing such large participation by the students in the special assemblies was overwhelming.

**Online Activities :** Different activities were also been planned and conducted online. On April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, on the occasion of Earth Day ‘Model Making’ activity was conducted. Gratitude and love was been shared by the young ones through the pictures, cards and videos of and to their mothers on the occasion of Mother’s Day on May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021. World Environment Day was marked as the day for creating awareness since the students enthusiastically participated through the Poster making activity on the theme ‘Best Out of Waste’. On the International Yoga Day i.e. on June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021 different ‘Asanas’ were performed by the students and related videos were been sent to the school. To show their love and care, students of primary grades were asked to make cards for their fathers on Father’s Day and this activity also received an enthusiastic response.

To celebrate Krishna Janmashtami, Bhajan singing activity was organized for the primary classes. Students of primary section also took part in Rakhi Making activity.

As part of the Govt. initiative in the name ‘Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav’ our students participated with zeal & enthusiasm.

Keeping up with spirit of values, the Jankians were motivated to take up acts of charity under the activity 'Joy of Sharing' on the occasion of 'Makar Sankranti' (from January 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021)

Apart from the above different class level quiz and presentations were a part of the school calendar.

**Vaccination Camp :** Keeping in mind the safety and health of our students the school organized a Covid Vaccination Camp for the students on January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 for age group 15 to 18 yrs.

**Career Counselling Session:** Being committed to excellence Jankidevi Public School never wants to let any stone unturned. So a career counselling session was organized for the students of grades X to XII. The guest faculty was Dr. Kavita Bhargava, a gold medalist in Psychology who has worked with many educational, health and research institutions in various capacities. She is an international Trainer, Mentor and Supervisor for Regression Therapy and a prominent podcaster for Psychology NCERT 11th & 12th.

**Competitions:** It is always nice to have healthy competition because it pushes you to do better. Believing in the same, the school organized few of the competitions even in the challenging Covid times. This gave the children a platform to achieve more.

The first competition was conducted on April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 for the grades VI to X. It was an Essay Writing Competition on topic of 'Guru Teg Bahadur and his Teachings'.

To celebrate International Dance Day on April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021 students of grade VI and above participated in the free style Dance Competition, through videos prepared by them.

On May 5, 2021 a vocal and instrumental Music Competition was held for the grade VI onwards.

May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021 witnessed an enthralling Inter Class Declamation Competition for senior students.

Grades VI to XII students also participated in an Inter Class Poster Making Competition on August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021

We tried to provide a parallel platform to the students who are good at aesthetic skills through Book Mark Making Competition on the occasion of Ganesh Chaturthi.

For promotion of performing arts, the school organized an Inter Class Song and dance Competition for grades I to VIII on Republic Day keeping on the Patriotic Theme.

The school continued to provide exposure to the students through external Competitions: like the Olympiads, Spell Bee, MSTSE etc. these were also conducted online.

Students participated in large numbers here too.
